Description

CalYOUTH in the Loop is looking for an enthusiastic advocate to amplify the perspectives of other TAY foster youth. You will be responsible for connecting with other youths between the ages of 18-24, who emancipated from foster care at age 18, or entered extended foster care, and collecting their responses to a short survey accessible through the CalYOUTH in the Loop website.

Responsibilities

- Reach out to your peers, youth ages 18-24 and collect responses to a short survey (7 minutes) which can be filled out on a smartphone, tablet, or computer.
- Advocate the importance of including youth voice and perspectives.
- Provide feedback on the reactions youth share when you ask them to participate in the survey. If they say yes, why? If they say no, why?
- Connect with the CalYOUTH in the Loop coordinator on a weekly basis to discuss any challenges or successes in collecting surveys.

Compensation

You would be paid an initial stipend of \$100.00 for participation in a 30 minute phone orientation and making a commitment to collecting at least 5 surveys. After that, you would receive \$5.00 for each complete survey that you collect.
